Blind Rehabilitation Center



- Opened in Summer 2011
- 26 inpatient bed capacity
- Private bedrooms with baths
- Training in computer skills, manual arts, mobility and living skills
- 63,000 square feet



Mental Health Building



- 64 inpatient bed capacity
- 98,000 square feet
- Outpatient services, residential and acute inpatient care
- Outpatient Clinics opened in Winter 2011
- First inpatient unit opening in Spring 2012



Community Living Center



- Eight 12-bed houses with capacity for 96 residents
- Each house includes areas for dining and recreation
- Houses are connected in an enclosed mall setting
- 105,000 square feet
- First two houses open in Spring 2012



Clinical Addition



- 151,000 square feet on four levels
- Primary and Specialty Care Clinics, Ambulatory Surgery, and a medical-surgical inpatient bed unit
- As areas are completed, some clinics are opening
- Construction to be completed in Spring 2012



Parking Garage and Utilities



- Parking Garage has 975 parking stalls open to patients, visitors, and staff
- There are no parking fees
- All utilities on campus were upgraded along with an expanded cooling plant
- All buildings have backup generator power
- As part of the Walkway and Landscape Project, a central lawn will preserve the pastoral feel of the campus



Other Projects

- Covered Walkway & Landscape –pending construction award
- Laundry & Kitchen Building – in design
- Physical Rehabilitation & Prosthetics Building – in pre-design
- Renovation of existing Buildings 1 & 2 plus removal of temporary buildings – in pre-design
