

PSYCHOSOCIAL RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION TREATMENT PROGRAM

Welcome:

PR RTP is set up to help Veterans with these health care and social needs:

- substance use disorders (SUD)
- military-related post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- chronic mental illness (CMI)
- homelessness

The treatment program is located at the VA health care system facility in Biloxi, Miss.

Kind and well-trained staff help Veterans develop specific wellness goals. Case managers help with housing problems, work therapy and discharge planning.

Substance Abuse Track

This 12-step program is set up to help Veterans with substance abuse problems. Veterans enrolling in this 30-day program must agree to be sober throughout the program period.

Post-traumatic Stress Disorder Track

This program is set up to help Veterans with anxiety problems related to stressful military events. Veterans who enroll in this six-to-eight-week program obtain skills to help them live happier lives in their communities. Veterans may choose from different treatment options.

Extended Stay/Work Therapy

This program is set up to help Veterans learn community living and/or job-related skills. Veterans with SUD or CMI may receive up to 13 weeks of treatment. Homeless Veterans may also benefit from this program.

Other Information

All programs offer individual and group mental health therapy using top-line treatments. Case management and medical services are offered. Veterans get help making a personal plan. Veterans also get help finding community resources.

Life on the Unit

Life on the PR RTP unit is fun and exciting. Veterans can take part in evening and weekend activities such as games, contests and movie nights.
